Ms. Desai heads a crowdfunded technology venture capital firm based out of down town Chicago. NIN Ventures (or <u>NIN.VC</u>) invests in Series A and B rounds of 3D printing, the 4th industrial revolution, cloud computing, virtual reality, financial services, education software, and other disruptive technology companies. The fund typically writes checks anywhere between \$1-\$5 million. <u>NIN.VC</u> has been featured in VentureBeat, Chicago Tribune, Forbes, Inc., WGN's After Hours with Rick Kogan, NBC Weekend Web with Charlie Wojciechowski, and Bloomberg's Taking Stock to name a few. And has been recipient of several awards including Wealth and Finance International Magazine's "Best Technology Venture Capital Fund - Illinois" for the Alternative Investment Awards, the "Best Crowdfunded Technology Venture Capital Fund - US" for the Fund Awards, and Acquisition International Magazine's "Best Technology Venture Capital Fund" for International Fund Fund Awards to name a few.
