Responsibilities

- Assist with a variety activities and programs during heritage/awareness months, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, and Veterans Day
- Collaborate with student organizations to facilitate student-led diversity initiatives
- Meet twice monthly with SCDI staff and fellow Student Diversity Ambassadors to plan events, discuss projects, and report progress on ongoing initiatives

Qualifications

Student Diversity Ambassadors should:

- Be a current undergraduate or graduate student at Illinois Tech
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.75
- Exhibit strong communication, leadership, and interpersonal skills
- Have a passion for diversity, multiculturalism, and social justice
- Be able to attend scheduled mandatory trainings and meet twice monthly with fellow Student Diversity Ambassadors
